

## **Butt Hutt Music Survey**

We greatly appreciate the comments of the 62 persons who took the time to respond to our survey on Saturday night entertainment in the Butt Hutt. Your votes and comments have been reviewed and will influence ongoing bookings.

In 2025, eleven acts were/are scheduled for Saturday night, each playing an average of five times in the year, and none playing the Butt Hutt more than six times, typically two months between gigs. There was only one band in the survey that did not receive at least one "unacceptable" vote. Another band, that received one of the highest "unacceptable" votes (27%), was also voted "excellent" by 37% and "decent" by 36%. (Both those bands regularly play other nudist resorts and local bars.)

We will try for adjustments to our remaining 2025 schedule as replacements are available for specific dates. Some of the more popular bands are booked up many months in advance, and many are already booking 2026 – some bands will already be booked up for next year in a few months. (For the Five Shades of Grey fans who asked, we have already booked them for five dates in 2026, including during Super Bowl South.)

For 2026, we will be eliminating a few acts from consideration for the Butt Hutt, that were deemed unacceptable for that venue. We will certainly be bringing back the more popular among our existing line-up, that each have their followers, while reserving dates for new talent as well. Some of you suggested bands by name when you did the survey. Also, some mentioned bringing back a few bands that played here in the past; the few names mentioned either declined returning or requested a significant payment increase.

From your suggestions, and from other sources, at the moment we have a list of 18 new talent prospects we are examining, to see which are good fits for the Butt Hutt, willing to play here, and within our budget.

To help with the 2026 selection process, we are introducing **SHOWCASE FRIDAYS**: this Summer, mostly on Friday evenings, we will be inviting in new musicians to play for you to sample and rate them, for possible inclusion in our 2026 schedule. It won't be every Friday, just as we're able to find and schedule available prospects. We've already reached out to a couple of bands and are awaiting a response to select an open date for them, if they are reasonably priced. It may take a few weeks to get this process going.

We invite <u>YOU</u> to join in the ongoing selection process by giving a performance invite card to acts you hear out on the street that you like. Cards are available in office.

## **Butt Hutt Music Survey** (continued)

Regarding some of the issues that were raised:

- VOLUME: Nine persons commented that some bands were too loud. Bands will sometimes poll the audience to ask if their level is okay. However, that is a subjective evaluation, and we have a decibel meter and the bartenders will be monitoring the actual sound level, to keep it at what is considered safe. The ambient sound level of the crowd on the deck—absent music—has been measured at between 60 and 70 dB. Rock concerts often measure 120 dB, which is way too loud for us. For the deck, we are considering an average of 90 dB, with a peak of 100 as high as we want to go.
- VARIETY: While some want their favorite bands to play more often, others complained there was not enough variety. As to genre, there were individual requests for salsa (1), jazz (1), country (1), "younger" music (1) and DJ music (2).
- HEAT: Four persons commented that the Butt Hutt was too hot in the Summer, and suggested improved ventilation or air conditioning was needed.
- TIME: Four persons suggested going back to 8-11 pm. Previous to the survey, others had suggested the current 7-10 pm scheduling. This is under consideration.

Thanks again for completing the survey, and we look forward to presenting some new musical talent for your enjoyment.


